MAUI DIVE SHOP PADI SCUBA TUNE-UP/PADI ReActivate Program

How sharp are your diving skills? Has it been a few years since your last dive? Why not shake off the dust, catch up on the newest safe diving techniques, and bring your underwater breathing and buoyancy up to par. We offer a PADI SCUBA Tune-up, a beach refresher which is a Custom Beach dive with an Instructor, or the New PADI ReActivate Program. Both options includes an assessment, review, in-water skills practice and buoyancy tune-up. If time permits, book a second dive to refine buoyancy skills and enjoy a reef tour.

PADI SCUBA Tune-Up: Complete the classwork or online eLearning, then do the 24 water skills you completed in your Open Water course. Upon completion of the Tune-Up, you will receive decal for your certification card and documentation in your logbook as proof of a refresher dive with us.

PADI ReActivate Program: With ReActivate, you will immerse yourself in dive scenarios and make decisions that test your understanding of important dive safety concepts, dive planning essentials and problem management. In the water, you'll practice a few safety-related skills and then go over anything that you specifically want to review. Upon completion of the ReActivate Program, a new certification card with the date of the reactivate and new picture, if you like, will be issued.

PREREQUISITES: Certification as an Open Water Diver or higher level from any

certification agency.

Completion of the Medical Statement- If there are any medical conditions indicated by a "yes" on the medical statement you will need the Medical Statement, provided by MAUI DIVE SHOP, to be signed by a doctor and returned to MAUI DIVE SHOP before you can be scheduled for the activity.

Completion of PADI Tune-Up Workbook or eLearning Program.

SCHEDULE: 12:45pm to 5:30pm (7:00am to 12:30pm if beach schedule allows)

TRANSPORTATION: You will need to provide your own transportation by car throughout the

activity. A taxi or bicycle will not be adequate.

NOTE: WHEN PLANNING ACTIVITIES, ALLOW 24 HOURS AFTER SCUBA

DIVING BEFORE DRIVING OR FLYING AT 1000+ FEET OF ALTITUDE.

Here is how to begin:

- 1. **Review the Medical Statement with the store staff prior to signing up.** If there are any medical conditions indicated by a "yes," you will need to send the Medical Statement Form to your doctor to have the physician complete page two before enrolling in class. You will need to have the physician fax the completed pages 1 and 2 or bring those completed pages in to a Maui Dive Shop location.
- 2. To enroll, make payment for the class at any Maui Dive Shop location or via phone.

 Purchase the PADI SCUBA Tune-up Workbook, the PADI SCUBA Tune-up online

 eLearning or sign up for the PADI Reactivate online.
- 3. Arrive at check-in ready for adventure. Bring, rent, or purchase your mask, snorkel, and fins. Wear your bathing suit and comfortable clothing. Bring your completed PADI Workbook, SCUBA Tune-Up eLearning record or your PADI Reactivate certificate. Bring certification card (from any certification agency at the Open Water Diver or equivalent level), activity voucher, towel, sunscreen, a snack and drinks if you would like. If you have your own SCUBA gear and would like to use it, bring it along. If not, we will provide a regulator, BCD, wetsuit, tank, and weights at no additional cost.
